# WHAT IS GIN

Gin is a neutral spirit flavoured by juniper and other botanicals, juniper must be the predominant flavour. This neutral spirit was traditionally made from grain, or for cheaper brands, molasses. However, the gin revolution has brought many other raw materials to the fore including: potatoes; apples and grapes.

Gin remained popular with the Brits, notable for its use by soldiers and colonials living in lands prone to malaria infections: gin was excellent at masking the unpleasant, bitter flavour of the antimalarial alkaloid quinine, a necessity for the susceptible foreigners. This medical elixir developed into the Gin & Tonic we know and love to this day.

**Tanqueray No. 10** 25ml **£3.10**

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Aromatic Tonic**

**Recommended Garnish: Slice of Orange**

This gin is handcrafted in small batches and is the only gin to be made with fresh citrus fruits (grapefruits, orange and limes) along with camomile flowers and other hand selected botanicals.

**Rock Rose Handcrafted Scottish Gin** 25ml **£3.70**

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Indian Tonic**

**Recommended Garnish: Blueberries**

An alluring botanical selection including locally harvested Rhodiola Rosea, Rowan Berries, Sea Buckthorn, Blueberries, Verbena, Coriander Seed, Cardamom and Juniper. They use a traditional copper pot still.

A full bodied, sharp, yet fruity gin with the taste of juniper highlighted by the sweetness of apples, Fever Tree Elderflower Tonic and hops.

Rich and fruity, with gentle juniper and spicy flavours, this smooth gin is the perfect blend of balanced botanicals.

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic****Recommended Garnish: Mint**

An usual overabundance of juniper toward a balance of botanicals. Aviation explores the rich, floral and savoury notes of lavender, cardamom, and sarsaparilla to capture the lushness, spice, creativity, and freshness.

**Star of Bombay London Dry Gin**25ml **£3.30**

England 47.5%

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic****Recommended Garnish: Orange**

Emphasises is on the top note aromatics, balancing the uplifting scent of ripe juniper with rich citrus and deep floral notes. Bold juniper is chased by bergamot, ending with a spiced roundness from the ambrette.

**Opihr Gin**25ml **£2.60**

**Recommended Tonic: Ginger Ale****Recommended Garnish: Cracked Black Pepper**

Opihr Gin is created using cubebs from Indonesia, black pepper from India and coriander from Morocco. Botanicals are hand picked to create a unique spiced gin and married with fine English spirit to produce an exotic oriental spiced gin.

**Bombay Sapphire**25ml **£2.50**

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic****Recommended Garnish: Fresh Rosemary**

Using the vapour Infusion process, Bombay Sapphire includes 10 precious botanicals that are held separate from the spirit in perforated copper baskets, and when the heated vapours rise, the distinctive flavour of the botanicals are released.

**Larios Gin**25ml **£2.20**

Spain 37.5%

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Mediterranean Tonic****Recommended Garnish: Lemon**

This gin gives a smooth aroma of orange and juniper, with an elegant smooth, soft and dry taste. The distinctive flavour of lemon and orange is complemented with juniper.

**Hendricks Gin**25ml **£3.40**

**Recommended Tonic: Fever Tree Elderflower Tonic****Recommended Garnish: Cracked Black Pepper**

Divinely smooth with character and a balance of subtle flavours, whose infusions of cucumber and rose petals create a wonderfully refreshing gin with a delightfully floral aroma.



# WHISKEY INTRODUCTION

A single malt whisky is made from only water and 100% barley. Although it comes from a different distillery, it can contain whiskies from different barrels, and even from different batches.

Whisky generally improves with age. Scotch whisky ages for at least three years in oak barrels. Sometimes, these oak barrels have been previously used to age sherry or bourbon. Oak, like all wood is porous and scotch that is kept in oak barrels seeps into the oak picking up the oak's unique flavour.

As the whisky ages, a portion of the alcohol evaporates, mellowing the flavour. The 'lost' whisky is referred to as 'the angel's share'.

Scotch whisky barrels are often charred before the whisky is added. This also imparts a unique flavour, and the charred wood helps purify the whisky.

Whiskies are often given a 'finish' – they are aged in one cask for the majority of the process and then transferred to another cask for an additional 6-12 months. This adds a richer flavour to the whisky.

## HIGHLANDS

### **Oban 14 Year Old**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 43.0%**

One of Scotland's oldest and smallest distilleries, Oban was built in 1794: the West Highland port city of the same name has grown around it. The rich flavour of Oban comes from being made in two small stills and slow-cooled in tubs outside to maximise depth of flavour. Oban is rich and complex flavours of the Highlands meet and mingle with the peaty maritime character of the Islands.

### **Glenmorangie The Original**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 40.0%**

Elegant, floral and the real backbone of the Glenmorangie range. A 10 Year Old single malt, Glenmorangie Original is produced by marrying the delicate spirit that emerges from Scotland's tallest stills, with first and second fill American white oak casks. A mature spirit that is soft, mellow and creamy.

## The Macallan Gold

25ml **£3.60****Scotland 40.0%**

The Macallan Gold is burnished gold in colour with lemon citrus, then orange peel and an interlacing sweetness that softens but doesn't eliminate the zest. A quiet note of vanilla is followed by dark chocolate with lingering floral and light oak notes. Citrus and boiled sweets rule the palate, along with hints of ginger and cinnamon while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples.

## Glenkinchie 12 Year Old

25ml **£3.90****Scotland 43.0%**

Glenkinchie is from one of the last surviving Lowland distilleries in Scotland, situated twenty miles outside Edinburgh. It is distilled in some of the largest stills in Scotland to make a light, crisp whisky. Glenkinchie is perfect as an aperitif, or at the start of a meal due to it's fragrant, light and appetising body and taste. It has a very aromatic flowery nose and is sweet and creamy on the palate.

## Highland Park 12 Year Old

25ml **£3.30****Scotland 40.0%**

Established in 1798 on Orkney, Highland Park is the most northerly Scotch whisky distillery in the world. With its windswept moors, craggy outcrops and ancient religious sites, Orkney is a land full of mystery and rich in anecdote. Rich and well balanced malty tones with the subtle floral smoke which makes Highland Park such a distinctive single malt whisky.

## Chivas Regal 12 Year Old

25ml **£3.40****Highlands, Scotland 40.0%**

Chivas Regal is a premium blended Scotch whisky aged for a minimum of 12 years and triple blended, to achieve perfect harmony. Round and creamy on the palate, Chivas Regal 12 Year Old bursts with the rich taste of ripe, honeyed apples and notes of vanilla, hazelnut and butterscotch.

## Dalwhinnie 15 Year Old

25ml **£3.60****Highlands, Scotland 43.0%**

Established in 1898, Dalwhinnie is produced in the highest working distillery in Scotland at an altitude of 1,173ft, with stream water from mountain lochs. It is a perfect Highland Single Malt Scotch whisky with a resilient marriage of speyside heather-honey sweetness and lowland intensity.



## LOWLAND

### **Auchentoshan Classic**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 40.0%**

Triple distilled and matured solely in American bourbon casks results in Auchentoshan's classic style. A lowland single malt whisky with the sweet aromas of vanilla, coconut and the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.

## EDINBROUGH

### **Haig Clubman**

25ml **£3.60**

**Scotland 40.0%**

Haig clubman 70cl - welcome to the clubman from the house of Haig. An exquisite drink of effortless taste and style, designed to be noticed and enjoyed.

## ISLE OF JURA

### **Jura Origin 10 Year Old**

**Scotland 40.0%**

Jura Origin is aged in ex-Bourbon casks for 10 years. Some say it tastes of oak with hints of honey, caramel and soft liquorice. Origin is the whisky that began the Jura story and is the perfect sipped as a pre-dinner aperitif. Pair it with scallops au gratin, lemon sultana pudding, Scottish brie and white chocolate.

## JAPAN

### **Yamazaki 12 years**

25ml **£3.60**

**Japan 43.0%**

Yamazaki 12 year Old is a pioneering malt in Japan, for which Suntory deserve great credit. In its early days, it was rounded and delicate...now it is more intense, confident and elegant.

# SPEYSIDE

## **The Glenlivet Founders Reserve**

25ml **£4.30**

**Scotland 40.0%**

The Glenlivet Founder's Reserve is a unique tribute to George Smith's vision to create the definitive smooth Speyside malt. At its heart is the perfectly balanced, smooth fruity flavour The Glenlivet is renowned for. It is skilfully complemented with a creaminess and sweetness from the addition of First Fill American oak casks.

## **Monkey Shoulder**

25ml **£3.40**

**Scotland 40.0%**

A unique blend of 3 malt whiskies from Speyside's finest distilleries. Made in batches of just 27 casks for a smoother, richer taste. A contemporary brand with a great pack, intriguing name and a witty, playful personality: The new face of Scotch whisky for a new generation of whisky drinkers.

## **Glenfiddich 12 Year Old Special Reserve**

25ml **£3.40**

**Scotland 40.0%**

Carefully matured in the finest American bourbon and Spanish sherry oak casks for at least 12 years. Glenfiddich Special Reserve is married and mellowed in oak for complete harmony of aroma and flavour. A single malt Scotch whisky with distinctive fresh pear, creamy with subtle oak flavours and a long smooth and mellow finish.

## **Glenfiddich 15 Year Old**

25ml **£3.60**

**Scotland 40.0%**

The richly layered Glenfiddich 15 Year Old single malt Scotch whisky is innovatively matured in three types of oak cask: sherry, bourbon and new oak, before being married in a unique, handcrafted Oregon pine Solera vat. Year on year this Solera vat is never emptied but is always kept at least half full creating a deliciously harmonious and intense whisky which gets more complex and intriguing every year.

## **The Balvenie 17 year Old**

25ml **£3.40**

**Scotland 43.0%**

A 17 year old version of Balvenie's best selling Double Wood. Still initially matured in 'whisky oak' casks before being switched to sherry wood to finish, the extra years give it extra depth without being overpowering.



## ISLE OF SKYE

### **Talisker 10 Year Old**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 45.8%**

Talisker is a Single Malt Scotch whisky that has been distilled beside the sea on Skye since 1830. An elemental style that truly reflects its maritime surroundings. Distinctive, easily recognised and bottled at the unusual strength of 45.8% ABV. Talisker is a full bodied and smoky, Island whisky.

## ISLE OF ISLAY

### **Bowmore 12 Year Old**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 40.0%**

One of the oldest distilleries in Scotland, established in 1779. The barley is still hand turned by the Maltman using the traditional wooden malt shovel. A lemon and honey bouquet with the distinctive Bowmore smokiness. Warm and delicious on the palate with subtle dark chocolate flavours.

### **Laphroaig 10 Year Old**

25ml **£3.30**

**Scotland 40.0%**

The original Laphroaig, distilled the same way today as when Ian Hunter invented it over 75 years ago. In making Laphroaig, malted barley is dried over a peat fire. The smoke from this peat, found only on Islay, gives Laphroaig its particularly rich flavour. A bold, smoky taste, followed by a hint of seaweed and a surprising sweetness.

### **Lagavulin 16 Year Old**

25ml **£4.30**

**Scotland 43.0%**

Lagavulin is a huge, rich and intensely flavoured Islay Single Malt Scotch Whisky. It is an 'essential' Scotch whisky that any connoisseur or enthusiast must have in their collection. Deep, dry and exceptionally peaty, possibly the most pungent of all Islay malts, Lagavulin is not for the faint-hearted.

# CAMPBELTOWN

## **Springbank 10 years**

25ml **£3.40**

Scotland 46.0%

Blended from a mixture of bourbon and sherry casks, the light colour of this malt belies the richness of its character. The nose has a wide range of aromas, from citrus fruits to pears and a hint of peat, while the palate shows touches of smoke, vanilla essence, nutmeg, cinnamon and the salty tang characteristic of the distillery.

# BUSHMILLS

## **Bushmills Malt 10 Year Old**

25ml **£3.40**

Ireland 40.0%

The distinctive Bushmills light fruity aroma travels over the lip of your tumbler to deliver 10 years of maturation mostly in bourbon seasoned barrels. Light fruity and spicy aromas with melted chocolate that rests on the tongue before releasing a hint of honey in your cheeks. A crisp and clean finish that gently dies off.
